Friends of the Library: Summer Book Sale

The volunteers of the Friends of Adams County Library System have been working diligently during the past six months to prepare for the Annual Summer Book Sale. Due to the pandemic, the sale was canceled in 2020, leaving us with thousands of books to be kept in storage, and waiting for this year's event. The citizens in Gettysburg and the surrounding communities have very generously donated books to the Friends, averaging over 2,000 books a month brought to our donation center at the library's garage.

This year's event will be one of the biggest with approximately 21,000 quality used books for sale at bargain prices. There will be 100 tables filled with books in a variety of categories, including Civil War, politics, family life, mysteries, fiction, home improvement and children's books.

This huge event could not be possible without the generosity of Gastley's Moving & Storage in Biglerville, who donated all the boxes needed for storing the books, as well as the cooperation of the Redding Auction Services, which will be the site of the Summer Sale, located at 1085 Table Rock Road, Gettysburg.

The dates and times of the sale are as follows:
Wednesday, July 28th from 12 noon to 7pm
Thursday, July 29th from 9am to 7pm

Friday, July 30th from 9am to 7pm

Saturday, July 31st from 9am to 2pm

Throughout the sale, children who attend will receive 5 free books; teachers and first responders will receive a free bag of books. On Saturday only, books will be sold by the bag for \$5. Refreshments will be available for purchase.

We anticipate a large number of people in attendance; therefore, we request that everyone follow Covid precautions, including masks and social distancing.

More Book Sale News: The Friends Spring Fever Garage Book Sale was a huge success, with a total of \$1104 in book sales. During the Gettysburg Outdoor Antique Fair on May 15th we received \$777 in donations, and \$109 at the South Mountain Fair.

The Friends of the Library are very grateful to the Gettysburg community for ongoing support and very generous donations to our library.

Mid-Year at the ACLS by Laura Goss, Executive Director

We are halfway through 2021, time for an update! I continue to appreciate the Adams County Library System staff who have taken on the change in our lives and have adapted to a new way of providing service. The staff has been instrumental in the reopening process including welcoming the return of in person visits and continuing to provide a robust virtual program.

We are seeing more and more visitors to the library facilities as people are vaccinated. While we continue to be open to visitors, we have not yet begun in person programming or use of meeting rooms at this point. We hope that will happen later this year.

The way our libraries are used has evolved over the past year and we are still seeing the results of that change. Many library users are continuing to place holds on materials and picking them up instead of browsing as well as using our virtual branch. Over the past year we have had an incredible increase in the use of the ebook and eaudio collections. The ACLS has changed the way we purchase materials to meet the preferences of library users, continuing to purchase physical materials and increasing the purchase of digital materials.

Summer Quest continues as an all virtual program this year. This decision to continue in a virtual format had to be made in January as we were finalizing plans and performer presentations. Many "Take and Make" bags are available which help engage program participants and enhance the virtual programs. These bags can be picked up at your local branch. There are even decks of cards so that you can learn magic tricks with Magician Mike Rose! Once again, the Adams County Library System and WellSpan are partnering to present the popular Get Outdoors Adams County (GOAdams). "Get Outdoors and Chase Your Tale" as you visit local parks this summer! Visit http://www.goadams.org/ for more information. Both these programs are open to library users of all ages.

Are you reading the 2021 Adams County Reads One Book selection? The 2021 selection is *The Water Dancer* by Ta-Nehisi Coates. The Library has physical and digital copies for you to borrow. Enjoy the read or listen and look for programs surrounding this title at all of our branches in October.

And thanks to all our wonderful Friends of the Library who continue to support our program. As you are aware, the Bookstore in Gettysburg reopened in October and the Summer Booksale is on for July 28th – 31st!

I truly appreciate all of our Friends who are working diligently to support the ACLS. Thank you!
