We will all surely miss her, and I especially, as she was always there to listen to me vent or help me when problems arose, of which there were many.

Now comes the bad news. As I told membership at our Annual Meeting, we have a great need for more participation on our Board. Besides being your President, I don't have anyone willing to serve as Vice-President, and I am also the Marketing and Publicity chair, and the Book Sale Manager. We have volunteers working in the Garage, but also have a need of someone willing to serve as the Garage Manager and can help get the books to Redding's for Storage. As of next November, besides myself, we have several people on the Board who will be stepping down, including the Chairs of the Fund-Raising Committee, the Recording Secretary, and the Supply Manager. As you can see, we have reached critical mass, and unless more people step up, I believe that the Annual Book Sale for 2025 is in jeopardy and we will no longer be able to accept book donations after our July sale. If that happens, it will be a snowball effect, and we may have to close the bookstore as well. We have already decided to stop taking applications for lifetime memberships.


BOOK STORE BITS
